The location is ideal due to its proximity to the Canadian Forces Base – Suffield, which provides facilities for:

- The Canadian Armed Forces
- Defense Research and Development Canada (DRDC)
- The British Army Training Unit Suffield (BATUS)

Another attractive feature is its proximity to Medicine Hat which is home to:

- The Canadian Centre for Unmanned Vehicles (CCUVS)

CCUVS is a not for profit company governed by a national board of directors drawn from industry, government and academia. CCUVS provides unbiased, joint use facilities to meet your test and evaluation or research and development needs. These include unmanned air vehicles, unmanned ground vehicles, unmanned underwater vehicles and unmanned surface vehicles.
